### DETAILS

- Entry deadline is Thursday, May 30, 2019 at 12:00 pm. One entry per person.
- Winners will be announced by June 14, 2019.
- Winners will help paint their mural on the wall of Finish Line Auto Sales located at 440 S Yellowstone Hwy, Idaho Falls, ID 83402.
- First place winner will also receive a \$250 youth scholarship.
- Mural will be painted Aug 2-10th. Selected winner/winners are expected to attend.

## REQUIREMENTS

- To be qualified you must currently reside in Bonneville County and be 12-17 years of age.

  Participant may be 18 if they are still a senior in High School.
- The attached waiver form must be filled out and submitted with entry. A copy of this form can be found on our website or for access scan the QR code.
- Artwork will be judged on originality, creativity, and how well it fits the theme.
- Artwork may not contain any profanity, sexual content, or gang related material.
- Winners will be chosen by a panel of judges selected by Bonneville Youth Development staff and community members; all decisions of the judges are final.
- Artwork submissions may be combined into a collage with other entries for final mural painting.
- Winners may be required to provide proof of identification to claim their award.

# GUIDELINES AND SUBMISSION

- Entry format accepted: **Original** artwork needs to be submitted but you may retain a copy as artwork will not be returned. Artwork must be a minimum of an 8x10 and is recommended to be in the horizontal position to fit the wall.
- Submit entries to: Your schools Art Teacher or drop off at 245 N Placer Ave Idaho Falls, Idaho 83402 Monday-Thursday 10am-4pm. Submissions may also be mailed in a way that protects the artwork. If artwork is drawn digitally, it is required to be submitted in its raw file form to prove it is an original artwork.
